## Session 14: Sober Intoxication of the Spirit

---

### Primary Presentation Objective

- Make a clear recognition that God will renew the face of the earth through the power of the Holy Spirit. He will renew the face of the earth, namely, by renewing each of our hearts individually.

### Secondary Presentation Objectives

- Discover the greatest way to prepare yourself to receive the Holy Spirit in its fullness - through the virtue of humility. The Holy Spirit always descends and fills the lowly, the meek and humble of heart.
- Discover from Christ himself that authentic humility is not just a mental understanding or disposition, but an action. Humility is a downward action.

### Essential Small Group Goals

- Helping the men have an authentic discussion on pride vs. humility.
- Introduce the men to the Litany of Humility and inspire them to incorporate this great prayer into their spiritual lives.

### Questions From Video Presentation
