Session 6: Word - Witness - Walk

Primary Presentation Objective

- Show the intimate link and importance of union between our words and our deeds. Uniting them and living with integrity is essential to advancing the Kingdom.

Secondary Presentation Objectives

- What gets measured gets done. Who are you going to pray for that needs Jesus? When do you have opportunities to evangelize in both word and action?
- Understanding exactly what hypocrisy is and rooting it out from your life.

Essential Small Group Goals

- Get extremely practical. When will you share your faith? To whom?
- Discuss opportunities for witnessing to our faith and hold each other accountable.

Questions from Video Presentation

- Have I ever explicitly shared the Gospel with another person in word and action? If not, what are the obstacles holding you back?
- Be concrete. Share the name of one person in your life who needs Christ. Why do you feel this way? Commit to praying for this person daily. Ask God for the opportunity to share the Gospel with this person.

Supplemental Questions

- What struck you most from the presentation?
- What did you think about the comparison between the union of word and deed in Genesis 1 vs. the hypocrisy and betrayal of Dante's lowest level in hell?
- What can we do to hold each other accountable in our small groups? For example, how is your daily plan for prayer going? Did you make one?
