Session 14: Resilience and Perseverance

Primary Presentation Objective

- Identify your primary mission in life - the target and goal of the mission - namely, for the soul to land in Heaven. Create a Spiritual Plan across four segments of time: Daily, Weekly, Monthly, Yearly.

Secondary Presentation Objectives

- Discover that the only real sadness, the only real failure, the only great tragedy in life, is not to become a saint.
- Make a clear distinction regarding the attributes and manifestations of the Kingdom of God vs. the kingdom of this world. Challenge the men and help them discern between the two.

Essential Small Group Goals

- Help the men to set their target and have a unified mission - to get to Heaven. Help them begin building their Spiritual Plan of Life.
- Understand there will be setbacks and shortcomings. Therefore, confession is essential. Resilience and perseverance are essential. Assess how they are doing with their plans the following week in your small group.

Questions From Video Presentation

- Do you have a clearly defined Mission Statement for your life? How about for your family? Do your family members know their primary mission - to get to Heaven?
- With the help of your small group and lots of prayer, begin building the plan for your spiritual life: Daily, Weekly, Monthly, Yearly.

Supplemental Questions

- How did God speak to you personally in today's presentation? What elements stood out or struck you?
- In what ways are you still awaiting a temporal kingdom on earth? In what ways do you seek earthly pleasures for your comfort - over and above God's kingdom?
- When do you most experience the kingdom of God in your midst and in your heart?
