Session 17: The Kingdom is Like a Dragnet

Primary Presentation Objective

- Help the men understand that they must become the bait to attract other men into the love of God and into the Church. They must also become the bait to bring their family to the dinner table and into the faith.

Secondary Presentation Objectives

- Inspire the men to cast their nets into the deep to catch more men and bring people together. Help them understand that it's God's job to separate the good from the bad. God can be the judge, our job is to fish!
- Teach the men a new meal to prepare for their families especially during Fridays in Lent.

Essential Small Group Goals

- An inspiring discussion on our role to evangelize, our role to be fishers of men.
- An honest discussion on how we are doing. Are we simply bringing the harshness of the faith or are we a source of joy, an attractive witness to bring others in?
