## Session 24: Working in Redemption

---

### Primary Presentation Objective

- Help to bring the redemption that Jesus Christ accomplished historically, once and for all, into our lives every day.

### Secondary Presentation Objectives

- Help men discover the sacramental and incarnational identity embedded into the mission of Christ. Help them understand that Christ founded the Catholic Church.
- Help men understand The Paschal Mystery: the life, death, resurrection and ascension of Jesus as the foundation for the Church and our daily lives.

### Essential Small Group Goals

- Have an honest discussion about the dynamic of a personal relationship with the Lord and integrating it with the sacramental life of the Church. Try to discover where each man is in your small group in this regard. Attempt to help them integrate the two realities.
- Help men understand that everything in the Catholic Church is founded and fueled by the Paschal Mystery.
